Covid-19 protocols briefings done with club members	GREEN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All team leaders to be issued with a "quick guide" to pass to all players within their team to show key information from this risk assessment. All information displayed on social media pages.
Participants trained to do self-screen checks before travelling to session	AMBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All team leaders to be issued with a "quick guide" to pass to all players within their team to show key information from this risk assessment. Follow Public Health England guidelines If in doubt, individuals should not attend.
Transfer of Covid-19 (Person to Person)	AMBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teams to arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before kick off time and social distance between themselves until kick off time. Teams to leave immediately after match has concluded. No hand shakes with players, match officials or organisers. No spectators allowed unless for safeguarding purposes. Players to sanitise hands on entry/exit to/from the court and at half time intervals.
Travel arrangements	GREEN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All players to travel separately to the venue. Players to arrive ready to play.
Changing/showers	GREEN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All changing rooms to remain locked and out of use. Players to arrive ready to play.
Access to toilets	GREEN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One way in/out system in place for entering the facility.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum 2 people in toilet area at one time • Follow signage at venue.
Transfer of Covid-19 (Equipment)	RED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Goals to be cleaned prior to kick off. • Balls to be cleaned prior to kick off and at half time. • No bibs will be provided. Teams to wear same or similar coloured shirts to distinguish themselves from opponents. • Sharing of goalkeeper gloves is not allowed.
Transfer of Covid-19 (Players to Organisers)	AMBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Team leaders only to register team in attendance. • Keep 2m distance from organisers at all times. • Organisers to wear PPE as appropriate if they feel the need to. • Fees to be paid via bank transfer prior to kick off. No cash on night. • No team sheets on the night. Any team wanting to record stats can do so by emailing the team sheet afterwards. • Register players online to avoid close contact on the night.
Managing injuries / First Aid	RED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teams to manage own first aid/injuries and should if required • Teams are responsible for own PPE in line with FA and government guidelines.
Managing someone who becomes symptomatic	RED	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Individual player should contact the organisers immediately who will inform all team leaders. • Team leaders to disseminate information to all players within their team.
